Learning Across School

In **F1** this week we have been doing 'Walking Through the Jungle' in stories for

talking. We had jungle animals from the story in our small world tray for children to act out the story and join in with the repeated phrases.

In **F2** we have been learning about places that are cold and the animals that live in cold climates. Today we found out that polar bears can be over 3 meters tall. That's 172 Uni-fix cubes, how enormous is that?

In **Y1** we are really focussing on our segmenting and blending in phonics. This helps us with our reading and writing. We are really enjoying our phonics sessions!

Y2 had a brilliant day last Thursday at Wentworth Farm. We saw lots of different animals and even had the chance to hold a 5 stone python! The children made us proud. Well done **Y2**!

support your child's learning at home and school. Journals are used to record maths 'CLIC gaps' and spellings as well as reading. We have invested a lot of money in them as a school because they can be really helpful in supporting learning. Year 4 Swimming

Swimming for the **Y4s** starts on **Tuesday 12th February**. This will be an 18 week block of swimming lessons. It is a fantastic opportunity for the children as all the costs for transport, pool access and swimming instructors have been paid for by school. These swimming sessions are part of the National Curriculum and are statutory for Y4 pupils across the city. Each class will have a 40 minute swimming lesson each week from three qualified swimming instructors.
