Learning Across School

This week in **F1** our focused activity has been to try to build imaginative 'small worlds' in the construction area. We have seen some beautiful and well thought out builds to include the 'wall of China', tower blocks, castles, rockets, trains, buses, a snowman, a village and bridges. Some of the children even worked together to create these intricate small worlds, helping each other to carry the longer and heavier blocks.

In **F2** as part of our theme 'all about me' we have been thinking about jobs and have had a vet's practice in our role play area. We have been busy looking after the animals there. We enjoyed dressing up last week too!

In **Y1** we have been seeing how amazing we have been doing with our Phonics over the last 6 weeks. Mrs Wayper and Mrs Bradley were very impressed when they came to do our assessments with us. Our phonics helps us learn to read and write, we can already see a difference in our writing books.

This week in **Y6**, as part of our WW2 history topic, the children have been looking at different sources of evidence to see what they tell us about the past. In particular, we have looked at the Sheffield Blitz and the amount of destruction and number of casualties that were suffered in our community. We have also been honing our techniques in PE as part of our fitness circuits - there are some definite improvements and still much laughter. We are nearly at the end of our first pieces of independent writing using The Write Stuff. Children have been crafting stories that involve a challenge; adventures through forests and woods and the pursuit of unusual creatures or fantasy objects. You can hear a pin drop when they are writing.
